#### Introduction

The project is designed to help participants fight problems on the labour market. They will be about market in the control to develop soft siklis, create a CV, prepare for a job interview, learn about different career paths and where to look for opportunities, and then use this knowledge in working with young people. The selection of partners also deserves special attention. The project will involve participants from both countries with the highest unemployment in Europe (Georgia, Spain, Italy, Lithuania) and those with the lowest (Czech Republic, Poland, Germany, the Netherlands). This will enable the exchange of experiences and very diverse points of view on the project topic.

**The main goal** of the project is: to increase the skills of 24 youth workers from 8 different countries in the field of professional activation of young people.

#### Additional objectives:

- Improving the knowledge of youth workers about the latest trends and best practices in the field of professional activation of young people.
- Improving the ability of youth workers to plan and conduct activities for the professional activation of young people.
- Increasing the number of activities for the professional activation of young people training participants will be more involved in activities for the professional activation of young people.

Participants from the Czech Republic, Netherlands, Lithuania and Germany should use eco travel, not covering planes.

### Travel costs part 2

Participants will be obligated to buy tickets prior to the training course in Poland till the 29.02.2024.

Money will be reimbursed by the LEVEL UP Association once each TC is completed based on the invoices and ticket proofs send by nost or via email (only electronic tickets, not scan)

Remember to keep all the tickets! If you don't provide original tickets, LEVEL UP has a right to refuse to give you full reimbursement. We don't accept screenshots, only original electronic inckets in pdf or goodquality scans. Allowed is using most economical means of transport you will find (2nd class, no taxis or private cars). Before you will buy the tickets, please contact the LEVEL UP association to confirm the travel plan and costs.

Important! ONLY direct travel costs are refundable - transport tickets. Refunds for hotels, meals, additionally paid seats, insurance (including travel insurance), or fines are not allowed.


### Travelling to Kielce

We will provide transport from Kielce to Święta Katarzyna. You need to reach Kielce. The easiest way to do that is taking plane to Cracow Balice (130 km to kielce), katowice Pyzowice (148 km). Warsaw Chopin Airport (170 km) or Warsaw Modlin (224 km). In the picture the airport are pointed out with a green flag and meeting point with a red plin.

From each airport you can come to Kielce by bus or train. From Warsaw (Chopin and Modiln) there's direct Flixbus or you can go to train station in Warsaw East, West or Sluzewiec. From Pyrzowice and Balice you need to take transfer bus to city center of Kraków or Katowice and from there, you can take direct bus or train - during the day they are approx. once for 2-3 hours, 1-2h from Cracow and Warsaw.

If you have eco transport, the easiest way is to find buses/trains to Warsaw or Cracow - from these cities there is plenty of direct transportations to Kielce.

You should buy tickets online. For trains, it is possible to buy it inside the train from the staff, but it's much more expensive. You can do it also in a ticket office, but it's no recommended if you do not have much time as the queues are long.

Regarding the buses it's risky not buying it online, because seats number is limited and just before a bus' leave it's risky. Also, it is not always possible to buy tickets from a driver.







### Accommodation

The training will take place in the hotel called Jodełka in Święta Katarzyna, small town in the Świętokrzyskie Mountains, about 20 km from Kielce (address: st. Kielecka 3, Święta Katarzyna). Accomodation in 2-3 people in room, with full board (breakfast, Junch, dinner, coffee breaks.











# Participants' contribution before/during/after TC

Before the mobility and after closing participants' selection, we will organize a meeting to get to know each other better.

Participants should take part in the whole mobility, arriving on 22th of April and leaving on 30th of April. In justified cases, departure a day earlier/arrival a day later is possible, only after prior arrangement with the coordinator.

For the mobility in Poland we are asking about bringing a mug from your city/country (new one). It will be used for one game:)

After the first mobility, participants are obligated to organize a dissemination event for at least 10 meeting participants per 1 person participating in the training (overall at least 30 per country). Dissemination plan will be discussed in details during the mobility.

After training in Spain, participants will prepare a plan of youth activation in their organizations embracive actions for 6 moths after the mobility.



### Participants costs

Organisers WILL NOT provide participants with travel/ health insurance. Each participant is responsible for purchasing her/his own travel insurance for the time of his/her stay in Poland and in Spain. Medical insurance is obligatory for all participants and team leaders. EU residents staying in Poland temporarily are eligible for free treatment in local government hospitals, health centres and clinics with the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). You'll need to apply for this card in your home country and it's recommended to carry it with you at all times.

The organisers are also NOT RESPONSIBLE for any costs related to a possibly needed visa to travel to Poland, it is entirely the participants' responsibility to be aware of and arrange all such matters. Food and accommodation are fully covered by the LEVEL UP organization for the first training and Cultura Creativa for second with the support of the European Commission's Erasmus+ Pregramme.



#### Useful information - Poland

#### Currency:

The local currency used is the Zioty (PLN), 1 euro = 4,35 PLN (it may be changed before the TC) and you can find currency exchange at local banks (machines and at the teller) and exchange office in maior tourist areas as well as the airport.

Credit cards like VISA, MasterCard and American Express are widely accepted

#### The weather:

The weather in April is rather rainy and chilly, but some warmer days can happen.

#### Public transport/trains:

While travelling by train you can buy the tickets at the station in the ticket office or in the machines that are placed at the station, although we recommend purchasing the tickets online. You can also get them on the train but you have to pay extra

Travelling by bus is really easy and quite cheap - you can check all the connections around the city on google maps as well, it shows it really well

#### What should I bring

- visa ( if required).
- towels and cosmetics.
- medicines, pills, - original boarding passes/tickets/ invoices,
- laptop or tablet (if possible),
- comfortable shoes and clothes
- board/card games.
- great ideas.
- things for the cultural night (food, flags, everything connected to your country)
- coffee/tea mug (for the mobility in Poland)\*

\*Each participant is asked to buy a tea/coffee mug. You can bring some mugs/cups typical for your country or region. The mug needs to be clean and new. The mugs will be distributed during the first TC. The rules of the game will be explained on the first day. The mug needs to be wrapped, others should not see what the mug looks like. Please bring it to first session.
